# ROLE OF GUARDIANS Contd.....

- Guardians are advised to send their ward along with their own drinking water bottles from home.
- Eatables /tiffin etc , will not be allowed in school.
- ➤ Guardians should not send their child to school if the child is having FEVER, COLD or any kind of ailment as their immune system may be weak.
- Do not send your child to School without mask and personal sanitizer bottle.
- Guardians should ensure that the child is wearing clean and proper uniform.
- Encourage your child to write slogans and make drawings on COVID awareness.
- Guardians are to restrict themselves to administrative area only.

#### **ROLE OF GUARDIANS**

- Guardians should attend the orientation meeting at school and abide by the direction issued.
- Consent Letter must be given to school before sending the child.
- Guardians must guide their ward in complying with COVID protocol at school and home.
- Guardians must themselves wear mask and social distance while accompanying their ward to and from school.
- Hand washing habit must be taught and practiced at home.
- Guardians must help wards with their homework and assignments, if possible.
- Guardians must maintain constant liaison with teachers / special educators.
- Guardians must monitor that the Dos and Don'ts prescribed for children at the school are followed.
- Guardians must ensure that social distancing norms and wearing of mask are followed all the time during journey from home to school and back.
- Guardians are to take utmost care and give priority to cleanliness of their ward.

## **ROLE OF STUDENTS Contd....**

- ➤On the way to and from school keep wearing mask. If you carry umbrella, keep your umbrella open and maintain social distance with all on the way.
- After reaching home wash uniform with detergent if you have another set. If that is not possible keep the uniform isolated for twelve hours and put it under direct sunlight next day.
- ➤ Remind your parents and guardians to wash your mask, gloves and cap in hot water and surely with soap and detergent.
- ➤ Do your assignments and worksheets on the noschool days.
- ➤ Listen to your teachers and guardians.
- ➤ Verbal assistance or gesture to peers who are not able to maintain social distancing and wear mask.
- ➤ Avoid junk food and eating out. Eat healthy food prepared at home.
- ▶Drink hot water/milk/soup at home.
- ➤ Last but not the least; remember you are the true fighter against this formidable threat called COVID 19. We must win the battle by all will power and continuous perseverance. We must not allow COVID 19 to compromise our daily academic progress and achieving excellence.

## **ROLE OF STUDENTS.**

- Wear mask. Use of gloves and cap is optional.
- Avoid wearing metal accessories like rings, chains, bangles and amulets.
- Use your own Sanitizer.
- Carry your own water bottle.
- Do not panic.
- Do not spit here and there.
- Do not rush or fight.
- Maintain social distance everywhere. (Class room, Laboratory, library, corridors) No one should be within one meter from you.
- Do not come to school if you are having fever, cold or any other ailment.
- Wash hands with soap properly after entering school as guided by your teachers.
- Do not touch your face with hand anytime unless it is washed clean.
- Do not form close cluster with friends.
- Do not share books, copies, bags or any other belonging of your friend.
- Do not share food or drinking water with your friends or anyone.
- Do sit at your assigned place as directed by the teacher.
- Do not leave school premises until the end of school.
- Flush the toilets adequately and wash your hands.
- Paint innovative posters, write poems, essay, slogans on awareness against COVID.
